FAST FACTS

- ICF provided the ideal envelope for sustainability and structure. Utilizing energy efficient windows and doors and foam insulated ceiling
- Six inch core ICF dead-men were added to multiple 4" core radius walls to allow prompt (early) backfilling of terraced concrete work in order to keep the project schedule
- Multiple ICF Radius walls were utilized to form the terraces and radius wall stairs for the arena
- The second phase of this project included a 33K square foot staging area for the Angus Cattle
