The ICF Builder Awards are an annual project-of-the-year competition for the insulated concrete form (ICF) industry. This construction method uses stackable rigid foam blocks filled with reinforced concrete to create buildings that are beautiful, durable, energy efficient, and disaster resistant. Winners are selected in six categories (Light Commercial, Heavy Commercial, Multi-Family, Development, Specialty Application, and three residential divisions) and represent the best-of-the-best. This year's contest attracted entries across the globe, including theaters, schools, condos, and residential projects of every shape, size and style.
